



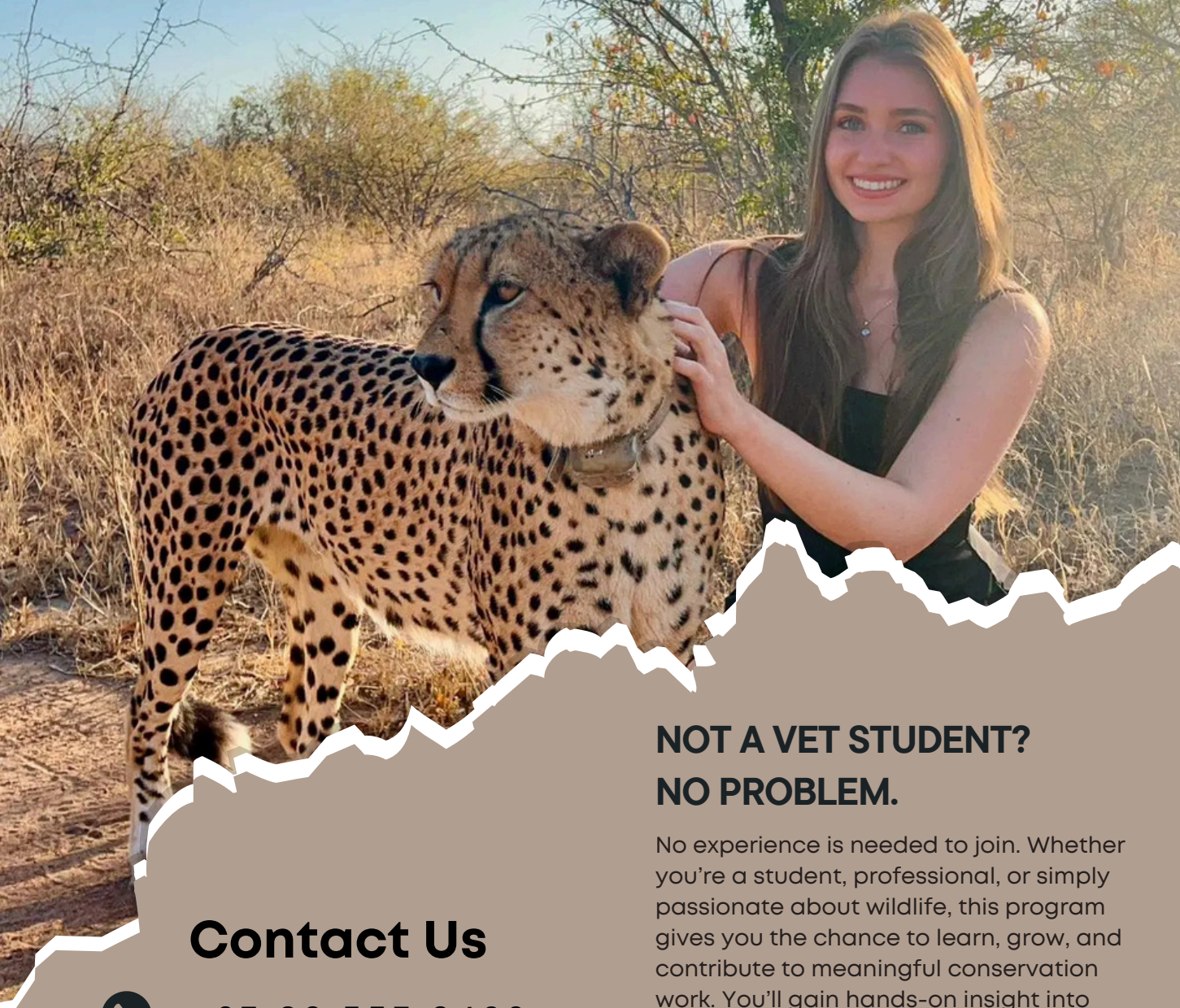

We understand plans can change — our team will always assist with rescheduling or transferring when needed.

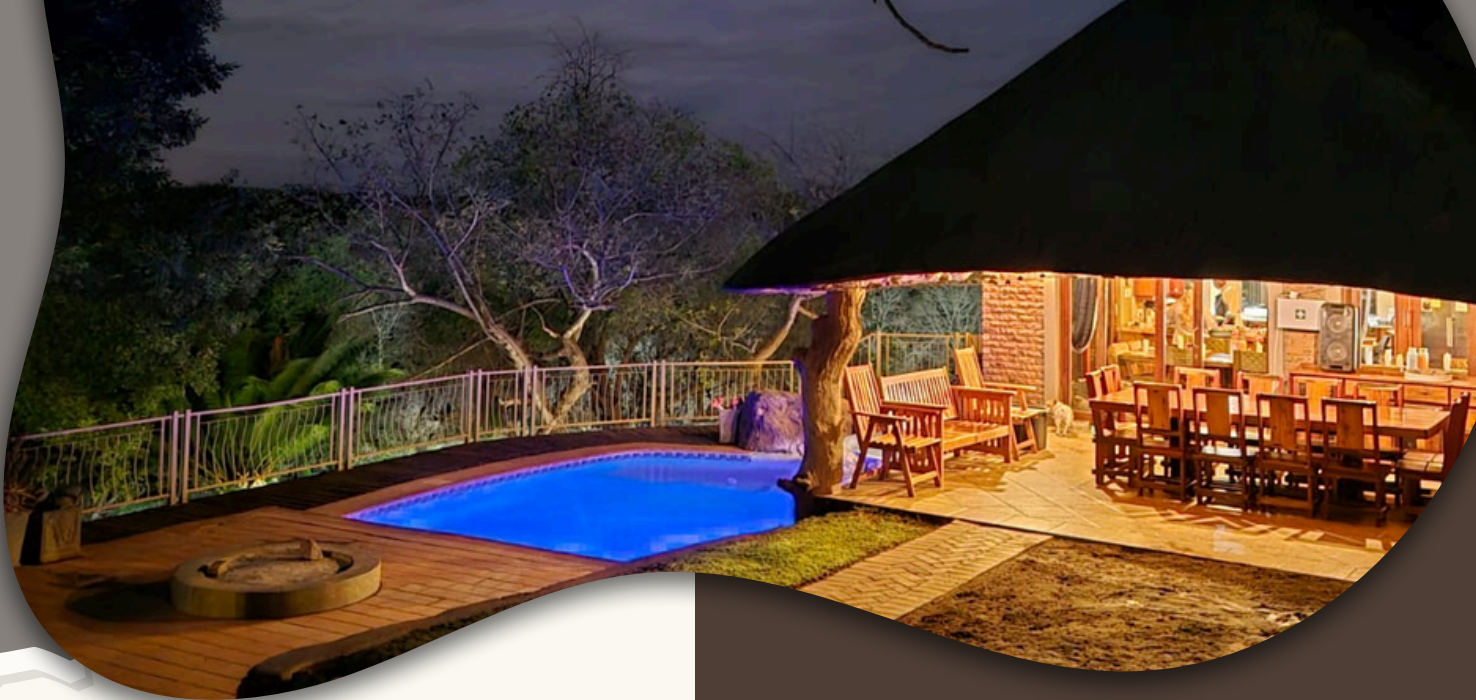
